The following entered statehood during President George Washington's term.

- 1st - Delaware** - December 7, 1787 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 2nd - Pennsylvania** - December 12, 1787 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 3rd - New Jersey** - December 18, 1787 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 4th - Georgia** - January 2, 1788 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 5th - Connecticut** - January 9, 1788 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 6th - Massachusetts** - February 6, 1788 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 7th - Maryland** - April 28, 1788 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 8th - South Carolina** - May 23, 1788 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 9th - New Hampshire** - June 21, 1788 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)
- 10th - Virginia** - June 25, 1788 - (1 of the original 13 colonies)

41st - Montana - November 8, 1889

42nd - Washington - November 11, 1889

43rd - Idaho - July 3, 1890

44th - Wyoming - July 10, 1890

The following entered statehood during President Grover Cleveland's mandate.

45th - Utah - January 4, 1896

The following entered statehood during President Theodore Roosevelt's mandate.

46th - Oklahoma - November 16, 1907

The following entered statehood during President William Howard Taft's mandate.

47th - New Mexico - January 6, 1912

48th - Arizona - February 14, 1912

The following entered statehood during President Dwight D. Eisenhower's mandate.

49th - Alaska - January 3, 1959

Hawaii was admitted as the 50th state on August 21, 1959, by proclamation of Dwight D. Eisenhower.

50th - Hawaii - August 21, 1959

The **District of Columbia** (D.C.) was established during the term of President George Washington. The Federal District Proclamation was issued on January 24, 1791, and established on March 3, 1791.

The United States acquired the following during President William McKinley's

mandate.

The United States acquired the territories of **Guam**, the **Philippines** and **Puerto Rico** on April 11, 1899, during the term of President William McKinley.

The **Panama Canal Zone** was acquired on February 26, 1904, during the term of President Theodore Roosevelt. Control of the Panama Canal was returned to Panama on October 1, 1979, by President Jimmy Carter.

The following was acquired during President Woodrow Wilson's mandate.

The **Virgin Islands** (Danish West Indies) was purchased from Denmark on August 4, 1916.

The District of Columbia (D.C.) was established during the term of George Washington.
